Mental Health Month

October is Mental Health Month: It's a good time to reflect on your own wellbeing and to check on friends and family.

Book a Safety Visit

Have you had your smoke alarm recently tested? If not, Fire + Rescue Smoke Alarm Safety Visits can provide this service for you.

What is a Safety Visit?

During a Safety Visit, Fire + Rescue firefighters will attend your home and check that you have working smoke alarms, that they are in good working condition, and are installed in suitable areas. If you do not have one, firefighters will install a long-life battery-powered smoke alarm as well as replace existing smoke alarm batteries **all at no cost.** With your permission, firefighters will also ask you to show us around your home and property. This will allow them to give you personalised fire safety advice.

Who might benefit from a Safety Visit?

Everyone can benefit from a Safety Visit, however there are people within our communities that are statistically at higher risk of incidents occurring, including:

- Over 65's.
- Those who live alone.
- People with limited mobility, hearing impairments or vision impairments.
- Residents who are supported by carers, family, and friends.
- Anyone with English as a second language.

DISABLED AND ELDERLY RESIDEN

What is AIDER?

AIDER is a one-off free service provided to infirm, disabled and elderly residents who live in bush fire prone land, to better prepare their properties for bush fire, in conjunction with the development of a bush fire survival plan.

Who is eligible?

Those who live in bush fire prone land, and who are infirm, disabled, or elderly.

AIDER services may include:

- thinning vegetation
- removing leaves, sticks and fallen branches
- trimming branches from around and overhanging the home
- mowing or slashing long grass
- cleaning gutters.

An assessment of your property will be completed by NSW RFS staff. Assistance can be provided to complete a Bush Fire Survival Plan. All works are completed by NSW RFS Mitigation crews.

A large, organized group of similar items (or a line of things).


